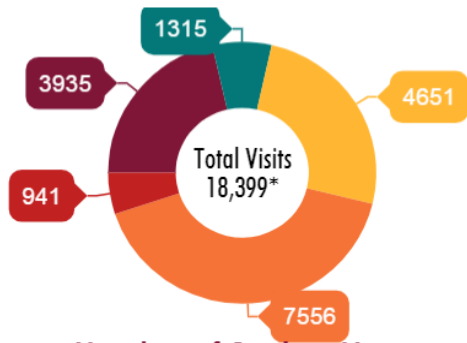

Library Notes

- Won FCPS's Libraries Transform Award.
- Surveyed students about library use. Responses are being used for next year's planning.
- Library closed for 12 days for SOL testing. Only one librarian needed to assist with proctoring, allowing time for Bookmobile and storytimes.
- Storytimes during SOL testing offered to teachers. We read to 51 classes!
- Took the library to the students over three lunch periods with a bookmobile in the cafeteria.
- Accepted requests for book deliveries while library was closed.
- Further increased library collection by 196 books.
- Participated in School and Public Library Partnership meetings.
- Planned and moderated #vaslchat, a monthly twitter chat for VA school librarians.
- Took four ESOL classes on field trip to public library and facilitated getting their library cards.
