Evaluating Sources form

Things to Consider	Reasoning
Who? Author of information. Do a lateral search: Can you verify the information from multiple sources? Who is the author? What makes them an expert? Can they be contacted? Check the domain (website name) Whois Lookup from Domain Tools Whois Lookup from WebTool Hub DNS Stuff - use the WHOIS search box	
What? Purpose, bias of information. What kind of source are you reading: Editorial? Satire? News? Blog? Other? Is it evidence based? Is it complete? Does the headline match the content?	
When? Currency of information. When was the site/article created? When was it updated? Is there more current information somewhere else?




Advanced Search Find pages with... all these words: Type the important words: tricolor rat terrier this exact word or phrase: Put exact words in quotes: "rat terrier" any of these words: Type OR between all the words you want: miniature OR standard Put a minus sign just before words you don't want: none of these words: -rodent, -"Jack Russell" Put 2 periods between the numbers ranging from: 10..35 lb, \$300..\$5 Then narrow your results by... Find pages in the language: any language region: any region last update: anytime Find pages updated within the time you specify. Search one site (like wikipedia.org) or limit your results to a domain site or domain like .edu, .org or .gov Search for terms in the whole page, page title, or web address, or links to anywhere in the page terms appearing: the page you're looking for.

Use a variety of keywords and combinations of words to look for your topic.

You can limit your results to certain types of websites to get credible sources.



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
