OUR MISSION

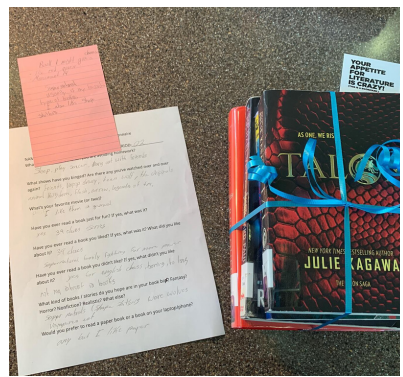

2020-21 STATISTICS

- A total of 46,789 visits from 2,031 students. That's 433 visits/day (while open.)
- Total of 103,471 searches across all databases. Top 3 are Gale, Britannica and Questia.
- A collection of 3,263 eBooks, 217 eAudiobooks & 15,735 print books.
- Checkouts of 5,513 books in print, 80 eBooks and 6 eAudiobooks.



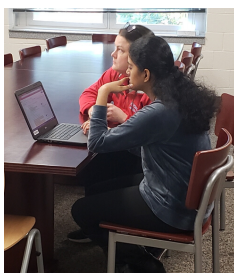
